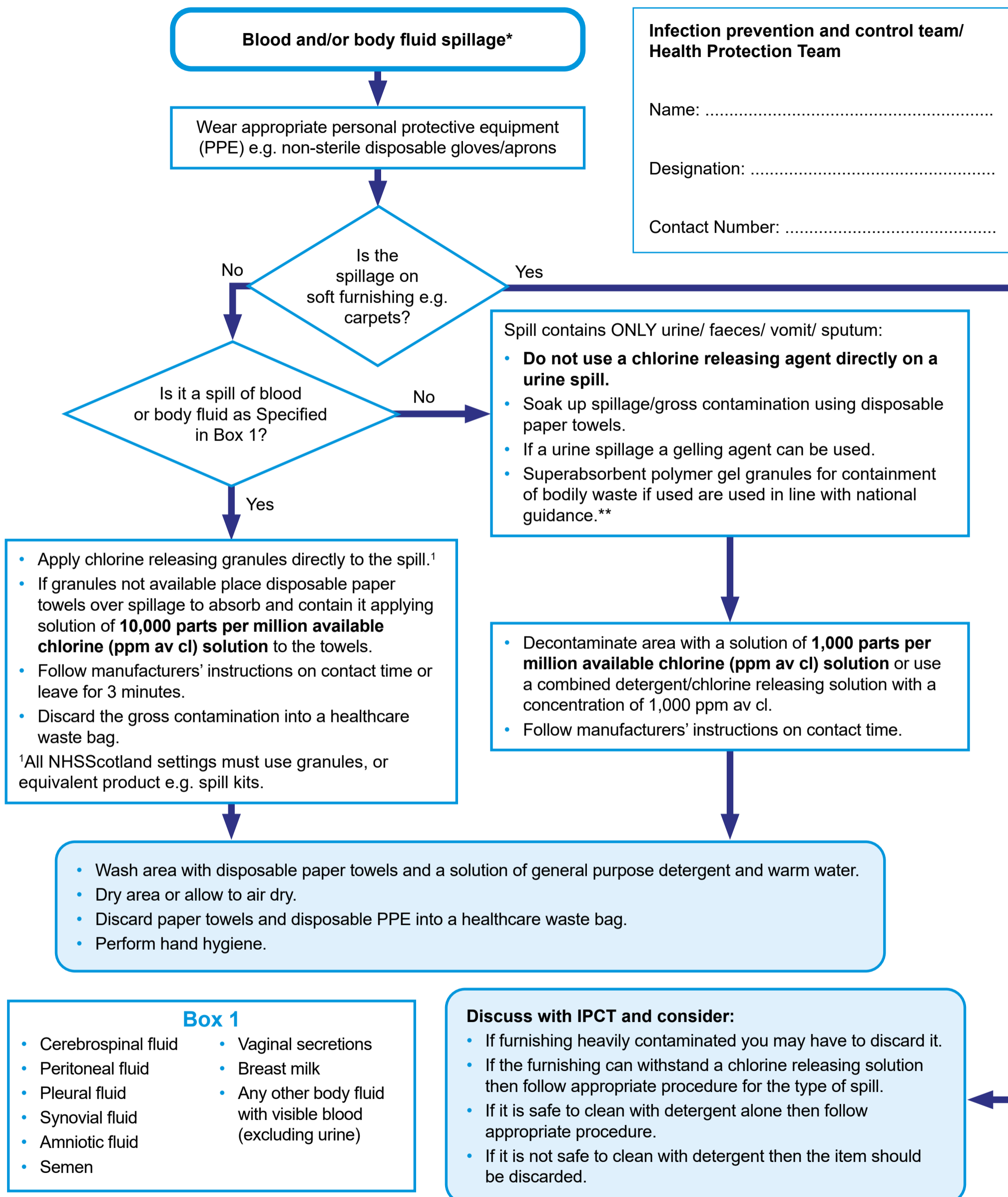


# Best Practice: Appendix 9 – Management of blood and body fluid spillages
